

Identifying the double crested cormorant (vs common loon)

The double-crested cormorant is a large waterbird with a stocky body, long neck, medium-sized tail, webbed feet, and a medium-sized hooked bill. It has a body length of 70–90 cm (28–35 in) long, with a wingspan of 114–123 cm (45–48 in).
